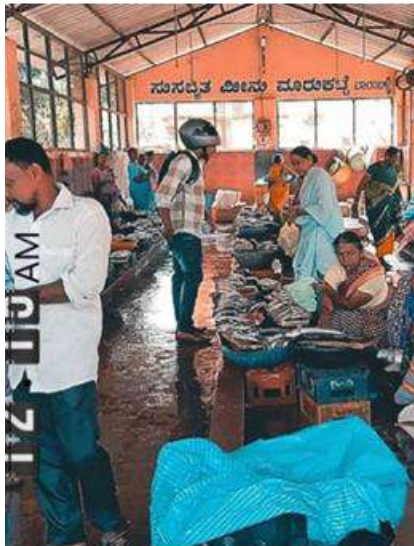

Only 25 students will be selected. The Club membership is open to all. Preference will be given to final year students.


