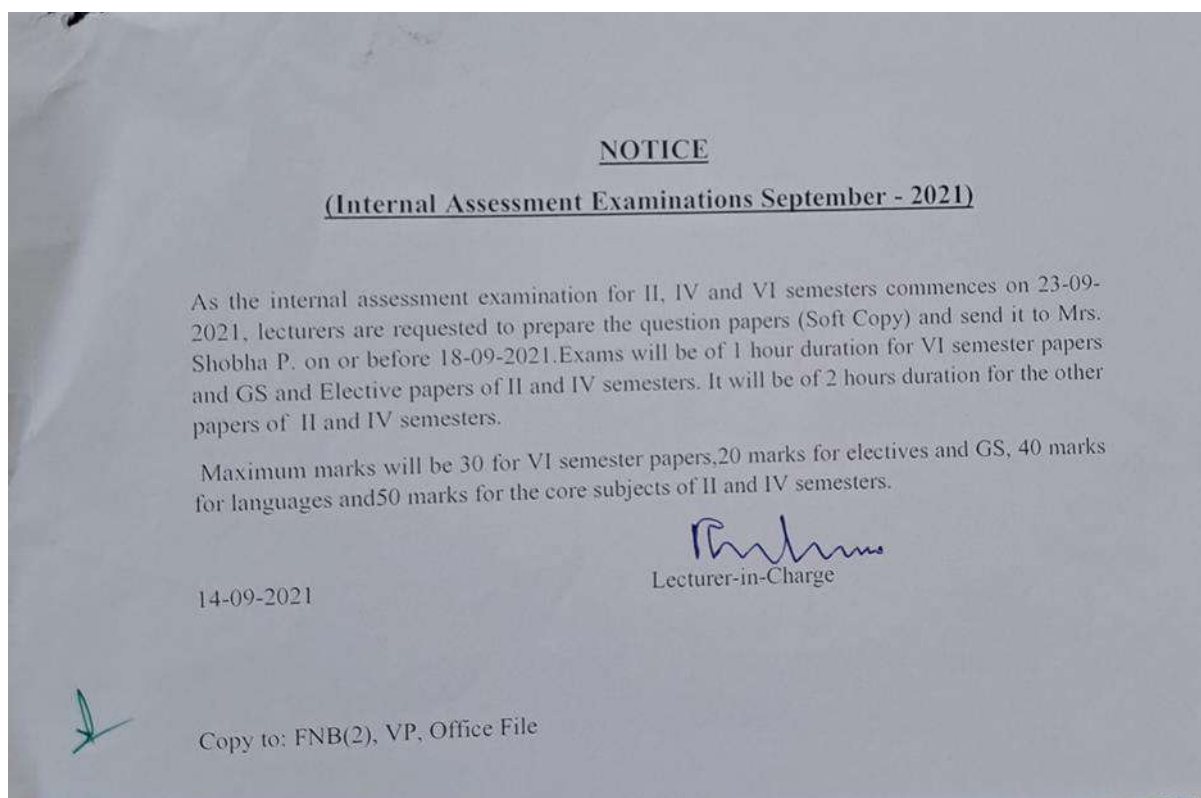
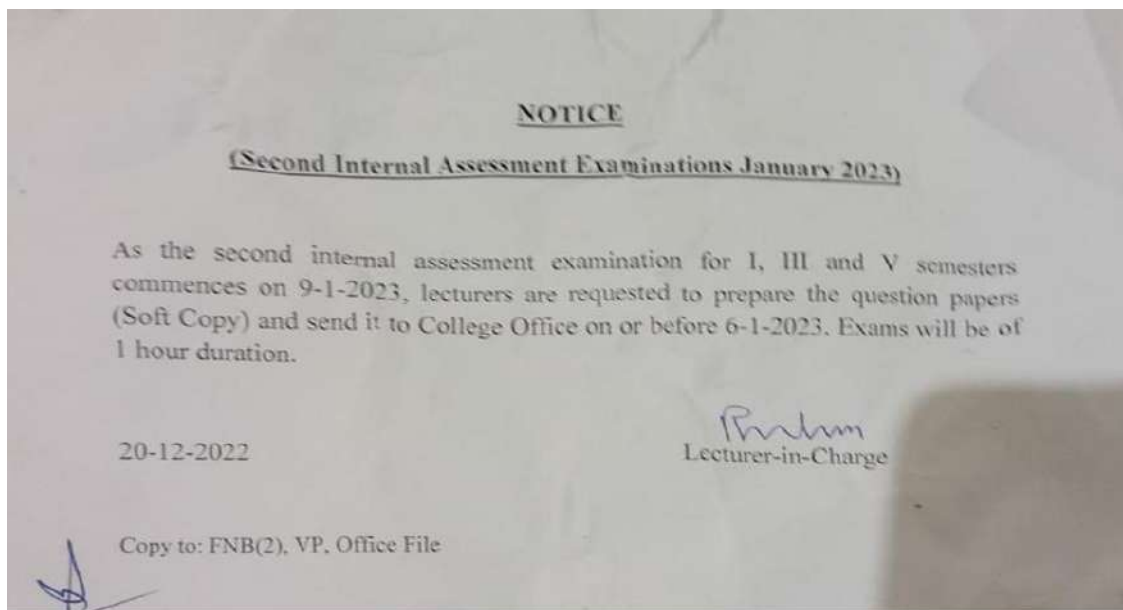
nally called the students to brief about the idea behind the novel scheme and all of them promised that they will be sincere during the exami-


