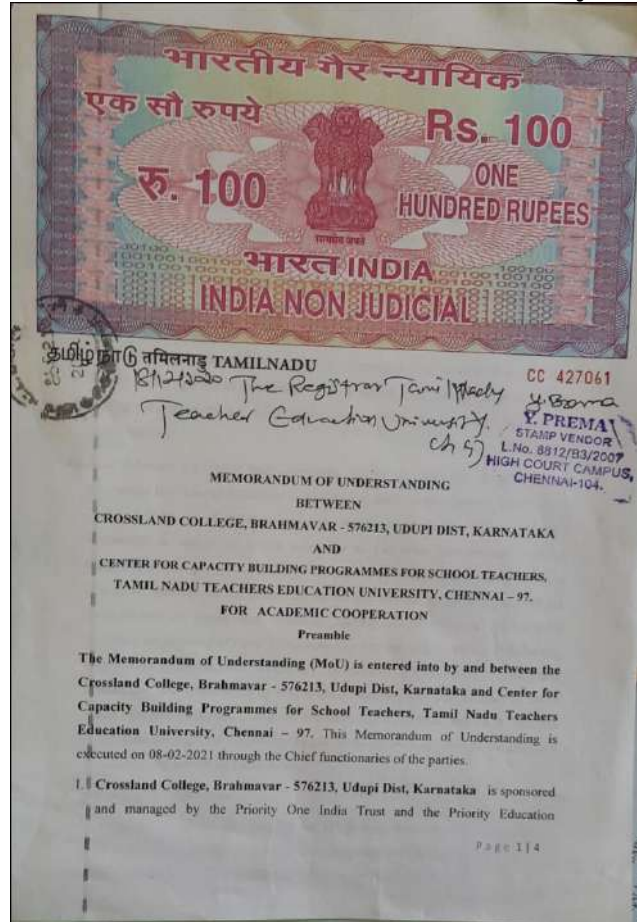
The meeting was held in the Principal's chamber at 11:10 A.M. The meeting was presided over by the chairman of the IQAC and attended by the following members

- 1.1. *To conduct and organize student's interchanging/intercultural programmes integrations without financial dependencies.*

- 1.5. *To strengthen the educational relationships between the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University and Crossland College, Brahmavar - 576213, Udupi Dist, Karnataka for the welfare of the students and teachers.*

2. Discretion:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is subject to the following:

- 2.1. *That the final authority in regard to its implementation and coordination of its activities shall rest on the Registrar of the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University and the Principal of Crossland College, Brahmavar - 576213, Udupi Dist, Karnataka.*
- 2.2. *That the Memorandum of Understanding will remain valid for five (5) years from the date of signing with the possibility of further renewal, and such renewal is subject to evaluation and subsequent agreement on the part of both the Parties/Institutions.*
- 2.3. *The Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University and Crossland College, Brahmavar - 576213, Udupi Dist, Karnataka agree that this Memorandum of Understanding may be amended by mutual agreement and that each Institution may unilaterally withdraw after three months' notice to the partner.*
- 2.4. *The functionaries shall meet at least once in three months for planning and implementation of the programmes via video conference or face to face based on everyone's availability.*
