SYLLABUS

Unit 1. Introduction to English

Objective: To make the students understand that communicating in English is no rocket science and it is the practice that is important to be proficient in English.

Methodology: Interactive session: Tongue twisters, Ice breakers

Ask the students to speak in native language on any topic for 5 minutes without the use of English. (Make them understand that English is a part of day to day life.)

Unit 2. Self Introduction

Objective: To make students comfortable and to make them know how to introduce themselves.

Methodology: Make the students to introduce them before the class covering topics likename, Father's name, what do I do/ where do I live? Parent's occupation, Hobbies, Ambition, Strengths etc.

Unit 3. About family

Objective: To make them familiar with relationships and jobs.

Methodology: Asking them to speak about their families covering relations, occupations, etc.

Unit 4: Learning new words (nouns, adjectives, verbs, adverbs) - Lyolhi (3-tanday)

Objective: To make them familiar with vocabulary

Methodology: News paper reading, Word anthakshari (adjectives, adverbs, verbs etc)

Unit 5: Verb Forms Johnson (

Objective: To teach the four forms of verbs and their usage.

Methodology: Giving them a sheet containing set of irregular verbs with its four forms and to drill them every day.

Unit 6: Role play

Objective: To make students able to communicate with people in different situations.

Methodology: Students will be paired up in twos and given different topics enact role plays.

Unit 7: Flash cards

Objective: To make students familiar with the vocabulary using flash cards.

Methodology: Pick up new words and making flash cards with synonyms on one side and antonyms on the other.

Unit 8: Group Discussion

Objective: Helping the students to interact effectively within a group.

Methodology: An interactive session on what group discussions are followed by a series of mock group discussions.

Unit 9: Dumb sharads

Objective: To teach the students the meanings of verbs

Methodology: The whole class will be divided into two groups and one group will enact a verb and the other group should tell the word.

Unit 10: Listening skills

Objective: To improve listening skills

Methodology: A speech in English will be played and the students will be asked to listen to it and later to write the points they remember.
